## Bruna Sperling

The artist born in Brasília 1987, graduated in architecture and urban planning in 2012. During her years living in the Brazilian capital, Bruna worked as an architect developing residential and urban projects, inspired by the city's modernist architecture and straight lines.

In 2013, she moved to São Paulo, where she started a new research and search contact with smaller scales of work - that's when she became connected to scenography and ephemeral installations.

In 2020, she began her artistic production. Since then, painting has been her main tool of expression and recently she has also been experimenting out into three-dimensional projects, creating a playful translation of her experiences.





'My research explores the intersection of my education and experience in architecture, delving into issues that arise from rigid systems and construction structures lacking the nuances of manual processes. This has driven me to focus on working on a smaller scale.

Materiality serves as the primary catalyst for my research, as I invest in layers and textures to enhance forms.

Vibrant colours and neon play a recurring role in my work, composing the backdrop for small imaginative creations that possess a strong pop appeal and incorporate elements of fantasy and surrealism.' – Bruna Sperling
